King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust is one of the UK's largest and busiest teaching hospitals, providing local services primarily serving the boroughs of Lambeth, Southwark, Lewisham and Bromley. The Trust is also recognised internationally for its work in liver disease and transplantation, fetal medicine, neurosciences, cardiac, haemato-oncology, stroke and major trauma.

On 1 October 2013, King's took over the running of the Princess Royal University Hospital (PRUH) in Farnborough and Orpington Hospital, as well as some services at Beckenham Beacon and Queen Mary's Hospital, Sidcup.
