Term >2 weeks of age
Pre-term >3 weeks of age
Conjugated bilirubin <25umol/L
or <25% of total bilirubin

Exclude other causes
Haemolysis
Breast Milk Jaundice
Sepsis
Hypothyroidism

Persistently high
unconjugated bilirubin +/-
phototherapy
