What is palliative care?

Palliative care helps patients feel as comfortable as possible. We help to control symptoms like pain, sickness and being out of breath. We often see people with serious illnesses who will get better. We also support people when they are nearing end of life. Palliative care is available to everyone who needs it.

Who are palliative care?

The Hospital Palliative Care Team includes a team of expert healthcare professionals who specialise in palliative care. Our team includes specialist doctors (Consultants in Palliative Medicine) and specially trained nurses supported by social workers.

How do I contact the Palliative Care Team?

If you have questions about your hospital care or medical treatment, you should speak to your ward team in the first instance.

You can contact us on the office number Monday to Friday 9-5. Office (direct line): **01689 865667** Email: **kch-tr.palliativecareteampruh@nhs.net** There is an answer machine if no one is there.

You cannot contact the team at weekends but you can ask the ward to contact us. If you are worried about something at night or at the weekend, speak to the ward team first. Ask to speak with a senior nurse if this is not enough.

Leaving Hospital

Ward teams will work with you and your family / carer to help you leave hospital safely at the right time. The palliative care team will help with some discharge issues, like recommending specialist medicines and connecting with community palliative care teams.

The Community Palliative Care Team

If you need a Palliative Care Team at home we will arrange this for you. They can help you with physical symptoms, social problems and any other worries. You will be able to call them day or night.
