#### Number of car parks

There are three car parks:

- 1. King's College Hospital, Denmark Hill (DH)
- 2. Princess Royal University Hospital (PRUH)
- 3. Orpington Hospital (ORP)

### **Parking Income**

Information is held in financial years.

The car parks at King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust sites do not make a profit. All parking money is reinvested into maintaining and improving parking, security and access or to improve services and the environment for patients.

We believe public money should be spent on treating patients. If the Trust did not charge for parking, money intended for patient care would have to be used to provide and maintain parking facilities.

Additionally, we encourage patients and visitors where possible to use public transport, cycle, or to be dropped off at our hospitals.

The below table shows cash income from 'pay + display' parking at PRUH and Orpington and 'pay-on-foot' car park at Denmark Hill.

Income from staff parking permits is not included and details on the cost of these are detailed on the subsequent pages.

# **Car Parking Charges for Blue Badge Holders**

Holders of valid Blue Badges (visitors) receive free parking when parked in a designated Blue Badge Bay. Staff with valid Blue Badges are entitled to a free annual KCH parking permit. Information on the number of spaces is provided on page 4.

# **Car Parking Charges for Staff**

There are four types of KCH car parking permits available to staff:

### 1. Gold Permits

For parking in all King's car parks. Peak and off peak parking at Denmark Hill, PRUH and Orpington. £75 per month is deducted from salary or paid for in advance in instalments agreed with the car parking management team.

### 2. Purple Permits

For parking at Denmark Hill site only (excluding the main Denmark Hill car park), Denmark Hill Business Park, Jennie Lee House, Faraday Building, Dental Institute and the Community Midwives Centre. Monthly deduction of £50 from salary or paid for in advance in instalments agreed with the car parking management team.

#### 3. Blue Permits

For parking in all car parks at PRUH and Orpington only. Charges are dependent on salary banding. Monthly deductions from salary or paid for in advance in instalments agreed with the car parking management team.

Bands 1 – 4 Monthly deduction of £25 from KCH salary.

Bands 5 – 7. Monthly deduction of £40 from KCH salary.

Band 8+. Monthly deduction of £50 from KCH salary.

# 4. Green Permit

Off-peak parking only (15:45hrs to 09:00hrs Mon-Fri). All day weekends (Saturday and Sunday) and Bank Holidays. For parking in all car parks at Denmark Hill, PRUH and Orpington. £120 per year, paid for in advance at the Cashiers Office or £10 per month from KCH salary.

# **Exemptions / Discounts**

Under certain circumstances, patients or visitors may be entitled to discounted parking - for example, in the event of a patient having to attend regularly (e.g. for dialysis). These decisions are made on a case by case basis and patients and/or their relatives are required to discuss this with ward managers in the first instance.

# Please Note:

- The parking arrangements for staff and patients/visitors are clearly delineated at Denmark Hill as the main car park is available to visitors (who cannot park anywhere else on Denmark Hill) and is also available to KCH (King's College Hospital) staff permit holders.
- The main car park at Denmark Hill is available to staff with the appropriate KCH parking permit
- Staff parking on any hospital site must display a valid parking permit or use pay and display

• Visitors can only park in the main 'pay-on-foot' car park in Denmark Hill

# Number of Car Parking Spaces for blue badge holders

We provide 58 clearly marked disabled parking spaces across all sites (see table below for numbers at each site). These are free to those who are registered disabled and have a Blue Badge. These spaces are located around the various entrances to the hospital sites for easy access. If these spaces are not available, disabled drivers can use the main car park, where the usual parking fee is payable. The roads within the hospital campus are private and they do not constitute on-street parking for the purposes of parking under the Blue Badge Scheme and are subject to our conditions relating to parking irrespective of whether a driver is disabled or not.

# **Management of Car Parks**

All of the Trust's car parks are operated in accordance with Trust Policy and Procedure and are managed by KCH NHS Foundation Trust. Some elements are manged via a third party.

Euro Car Parks patrol the car parks at the PRUH and Orpington and provide and install compliant signage and the ticket machines in the car parks. Euro Car Parks manage the issue of parking tickets and enforcement of parking fines.

Car Parking Partnership (CPP) provides similar services at Denmark Hill (although the ticket machines and barrier to the main car park at Denmark Hill are Trust assets).

All of the KCH car parks are operated in accordance with Trust Policy and Procedure and are managed by KCH NHS Foundation Trust.

The contracts for the management of the car parks are reviewed annually and the contract runs from  $1^{st}$  October –  $30^{th}$  September.

85%:15% share at Denmark Hill. 85% to CPP, 15% to KCH 60%:40% share at PRUH and Orpington. 60% to ECP, 40% to KCH
