

Do you have Hyperemesis Gravidarum (HG)?

Hyperemesis Gravidarum (HG) affects up to 3% of pregnant women and is the leading cause of hospitalization in early pregnancy. It is a serious medical condition. HG can take a major physical and mental toll on pregnant women and their families.

Women who suffer from HG experience excessive and intolerable vomiting and nausea during pregnancy. It can lead to extreme loss of quality of life, pre-term birth, low birth weight and possibly unfavorable pregnancy outcome. Medicine options are limited for HG, thus clinical trials participation of individuals with HG is much needed in the development of potential new effective therapies.

You may be eligible for the EMERALD study

A clinical trial known as EMERALD is now open to pregnant women with HG.
